NOTICE INVITING TENDER

The Executive Engineer, PHE & Water Supply Division Namsai on behalf of Governor of Arunachal Pradesh invites sealed item rate tender from the eligible and approved contractors registered with PHED/PWD/RWD/WRD/ UD/NEEPCO/NBCC/NHPC/BRO/MES/ CPWD for the work stated below under BE 2021-22.

1. The Tender shall be submitted in two bids viz. (i) Technical Bids (ii) Price Bids, each of bids shall be placed and sealed properly in two separate cover for each works and mailed by registered AD post/ in person, so as to reach to the undersigned within 1030 hrs of 03.03.2023. The authority inviting tender will not be held responsible for the delay if any, in the delivery of the documents or non-receipt of the same in time.
2. The tender bidder should prepare the technical bid after visiting the actual sites of construction and for design & drawing of various components of works, which they have to contact the Assistant Engineer, PHE & WS Sub Division, Namsai before collection of tender paper.
3. The technical bids shall be first opened in the Office Conference Hall of the Executive Engineer, PHE & WS Division, Namsai on 03.03.2023 at 1100 hrs in presence of intending contractors or their authorized representatives and will be evaluated to assess the technical viability, capability, work experience and financial capability of the contractor/firms and then only the financial bid of the qualified contractors/firms shall be opened after the approval of the technical bid by the competent authority. The technical & financial bids will be evaluated by standing screening committee whose decision shall be final.
4. Tender documents can be obtained from the office of the undersigned on any working day in between 1000 hrs to 1600 hrs on payment of Rs.1000/- (Rupees One thousand) only for Sl No. 1 & 2 and Rs.500/- (Rupees Five hundred) only for Sl No. 3 in cash or in the shape of DD (non-refundable) in favour of the Executive Engineer, PHE&WS Division, Namsai payable at the State Bank of India, Chowkham branch with effect from 23.02.2023 to 03/03/2023 upto 1030 hrs. No tender paper shall be issued to contractor after the stipulated time.
5. The bids must be accompanied by earnest money of amount specified as indicated in Column 5 only against each tender Package in the form of FDR/DD/DCR/Bankers Cheque of any nationalized bank/A.P. Co-operative Apex bank Ltd. issued in favour of the Executive Engineer, PHE & WS Division, Namsai in a separate envelop mentioned as "Earnest Money" on it along with the tender. No other kind of deposit as earnest money will be accepted. The tender without earnest money shall be summarily rejected. The earnest money has been relaxed, reduced for APST contractors @ 1% of rendered costs in pursuance of Govt. order.
6. The undersigned reserves the right to reject any or all tenders without assigning reason.
7. All registered contractors in minimum Class- IV & III category for Sl. No. 1&2 and contractors in minimum Class- V & IV category for Sl. No 3 and domiciled within the territorial jurisdiction of Namsai District are the minimum eligibility to participate in the tender in pursuance of the Arunachal Pradesh District Based Entrepreneurs and Professionals (Incentives, Development and Promotional) Rule 2015 vide Commissioner, PWD, Govt. of Arunachal Pradesh order No.SWD/W-66/2012 Dtd.13/08/2015 and as per the Rule of Sl. No.04 (f).
8. All other terms and conditions may be seen in the Tender Documents.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS:-

- (i.) The firm willing to submit tender must have executed similar type of works in the past or three similar works costing not less than Rs. 100.00 Lakhs during the last 2(Two) years
- (ii.) The firm must have adequate manpower of technical expertise and necessary equipments, to handle such project. At least one Graduate Engineer having minimum three years experience should be in the Pay Roll of the Tenderer.
- (iii.) The Firm should be able to complete the project within 12 (Twelve) months from the date of agreement for the works.
- (iv.) Firm must have sound financial back ground to complete the work even on the eventuality of unavoidable delay in payment owing to such reason as financial crunch of the client department/ government No interest will however be paid for the delay in payment.
- (v.) The firm should submit GST registration certificate, income tax clearance certificate,. Also latest audit report of last 3 (three) years duly certified / audited by the Chartered Accountant should be submitted.
- (vi.) The firm should not form any joint venture or enter into association with the agency for execution or sub-contract at any stage.
- (vii.) The selected firm on acceptance of tender shall have to pay security deposit amounting to 10% of the cost of work put to tender, out of which 5% shall have to be paid at the time of signing of agreement in the form of DCR issued by a Nationalized Bank and the balance 5% shall be deducted from the bills.
- (viii.) No advance payment in the form of mobilization charges will be made to the successful tenderer.
- (ix.) Black listed firm and Construction Company against whom black listing contemplated need not apply.
- (x.) Any firm not fulfilling above conditions need not apply. Apart from above, all documentary evidence/terms and conditions etc. in support of the order of the firm may be included /indicated. The interested firm should make site inspection prior to submission of the tender.
- (xi.) The competent authority on behalf of the Governor of Arunachal Pradesh does not bind itself to accept the lowest or any other tender and reserves to itself the authority to reject any or all the tenders received without the assignment of any reason. All tenders in which any of the prescribed condition is not fulfilled or any condition including that of conditional rebate is put forth by the tenderer shall be summarily rejected.
- (xii.) Canvassing whether directly or indirectly, in connection with tenders is strictly prohibited and the tenders submitted by the contractors who resort to canvassing will be liable to rejection.
- (xiii.) The competent authority on behalf of the Governor of Arunachal Pradesh reserves to himself the right of accepting the whole or any part of the tender and the tenderer shall be bound to perform the same at the rate quoted.
- (xiv.) This Notice Inviting Tender shall form a part of the contract document. The successful Bidder /Contractor, on acceptance of his tender by the accepting authority shall sign the contract agreement within 15 days(fifteen) day, from the date of acceptance.
- (xv.) After evaluation of technical bids of the contractor, if found unsatisfactory shall be summarily rejected and their price bid shall not be opened for further scrutiny.
- (xvi.) The undersigned reserves the right to reject the lowest rate quoted by the tenderer if found unjustified which may leads to sub-standard quality of work.
- (xvii.) Payment shall be subject to release of fund from GoI. & sanction/budgetary coverage provided thereof from the state Govt.
- (xviii.) Under no circumstances, request for time extension of tender period shall be entertained.
- (xvii) No price escalation clause shall apply.
